About the Project

OCTA, in coordination with Metrolink, will upgrade safety features at six stations in Orange County. Improvements will include removal and replacement of yellow detectable warning tiles and other directional tiles, as well as restriping of station platforms. Six stations will receive these upgrades: Buena Park, Fullerton, Orange, Santa Ana, Laguna Niguel/Mission Viejo, and San Clemente.

Construction Beginning Soon!

The contractor is expected to begin work at the Laguna Niguel/Mission Viejo Station as early as Wednesday, Feb. 24, and continue for approximately four weeks.

Construction is set for 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.



What to Expect

- Construction areas will be cordoned off.
- Crews will be using a jackhammer for this work.
- Please be advised that this work may be loud.
- Rail service will not be affected by the project.
