The OCTA Board adopted support positions on:

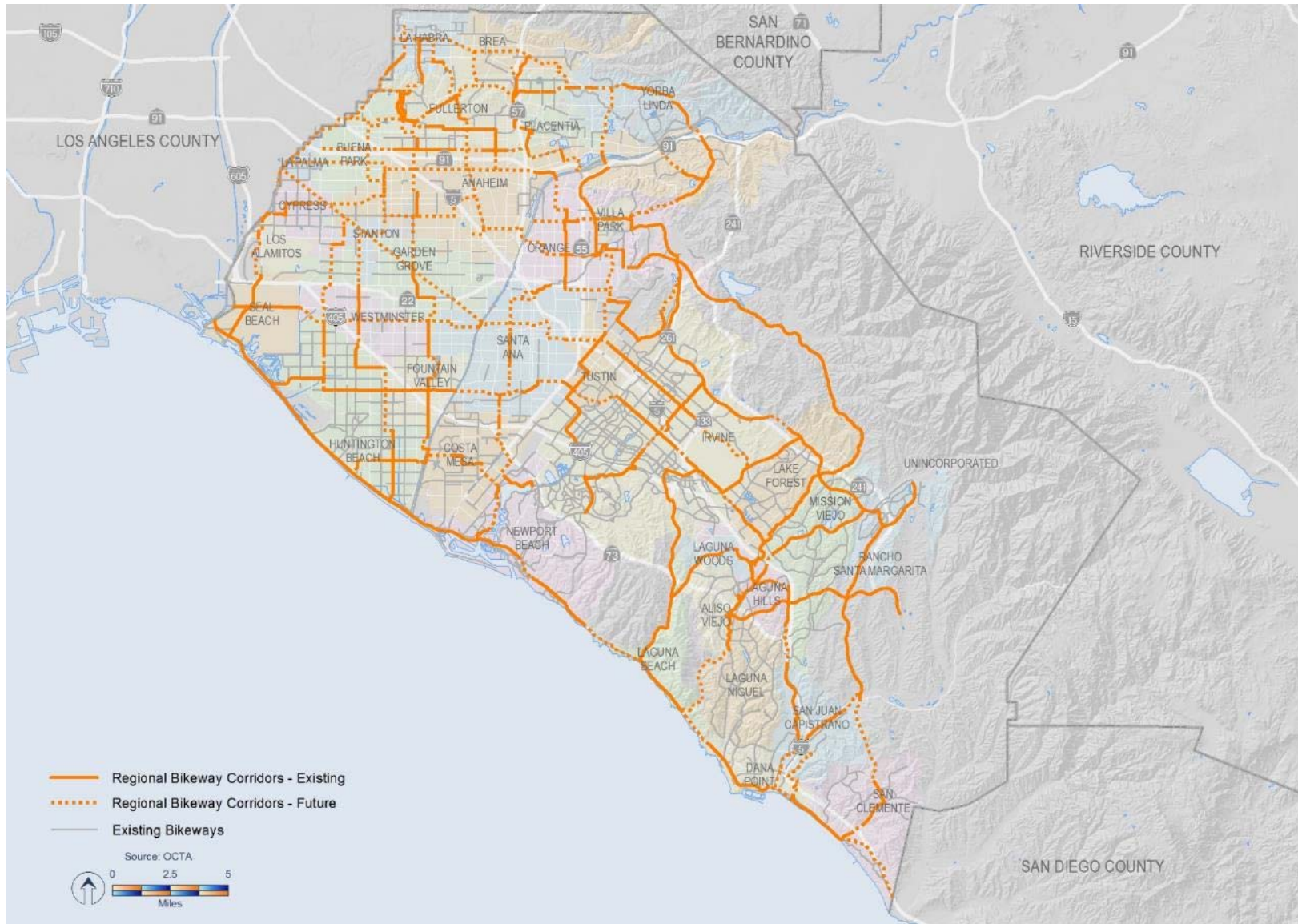
- AB 534 (Linder, R-Corona) – Addressed penalties and fines related to hit-and-run convictions.
- AB 902 (Bloom, D-Santa Monica) – Expands eligibility for bicycle “traffic school.” AB 902 was signed into law in September 2015.

West/Central Orange County (Districts 1 and 2)	Complete <i>Winter 2013</i>
South Orange County (District 5)	Complete <i>Spring 2015</i>
Orange County Foothills (District 3)	Complete* <i>Winter 2015</i>
