



SAN JUAN CREEK BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT



About the Project

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in coordination with Metrolink, is replacing the railroad bridge over San Juan Creek in the City of San Juan Capistrano to enhance safety and reduce maintenance needs. Once the new bridge is completed and train service is switched over, the existing bridge will be demolished. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2027.

San Juan Creek Trail Update

Pedestrians and bicyclists will be briefly stopped by flaggers while equipment is being moved around the San Juan Creek Trail and bridge work around the trail continues. Once the area is cleared, trail users may proceed. A full trail closure is expected in June. More details will be available in future communications.



Construction Activities

Sheet Pile Installation

Crews are continuing to install steel beams, also referred to as “sheet piles,” through mid-June on weekdays from 6 a.m. to 5 p.m. This work requires drilling 100-foot-long sheet piles along the slope embankment within San Juan Creek using vibratory and diesel hammers. The surrounding community may be impacted by noise and vibration from this activity.

This work may be loud. Schedule is subject to change due to inclement weather or unforeseen operational issues.
