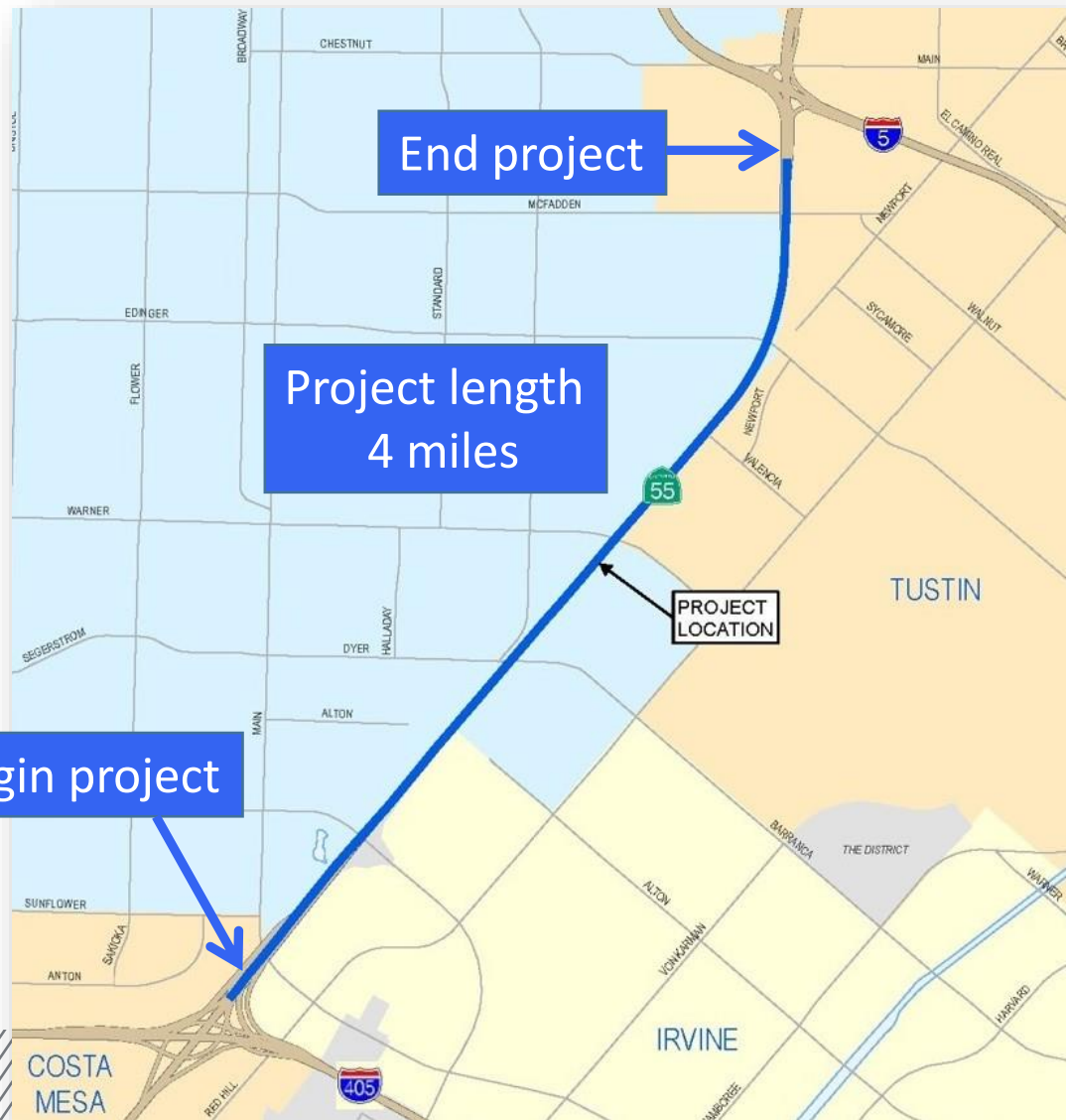




State Route 55 Improvement Project from Interstate 405 to Interstate 5

Project Limits

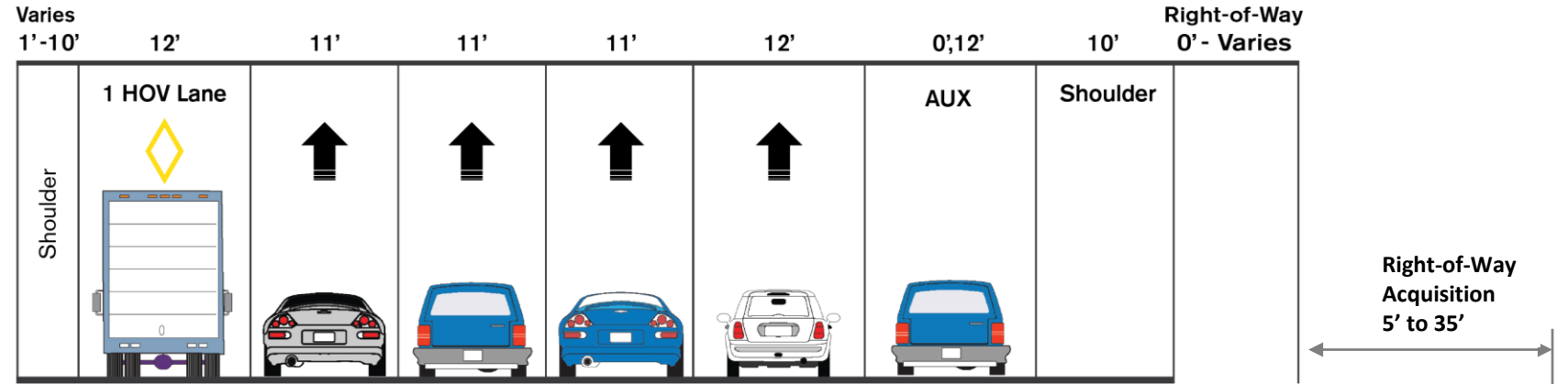


- Borders cities of Irvine, Santa Ana, and Tustin (Cities)
- Partnership with California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and Cities
- Project F in Measure M2 (M2)
- Project is included in the Next 10 Delivery Plan for implementation through construction

- Corridor cities including Irvine, Santa Ana, and Tustin support the project
- Project was included in past M2 Early Action Plan and M2020 updates
- Orange County Transportation Authority Board of Directors (Board) directed staff to accelerate delivery of the project
- In June 2017, the Board approved the design cooperative agreement with Caltrans to initiate the project design
- In September 2017, the Board authorized right-of-way (ROW) acquisition
- Project is included in the Next 10 Delivery Plan for implementation through construction

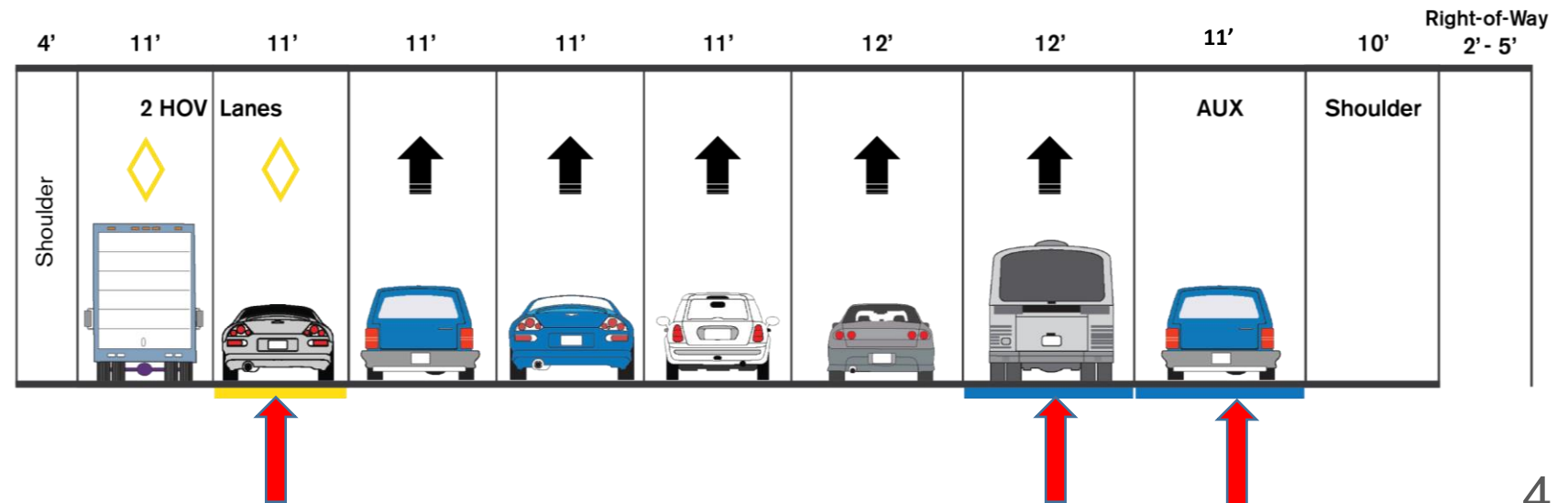
Project Improvements

Existing

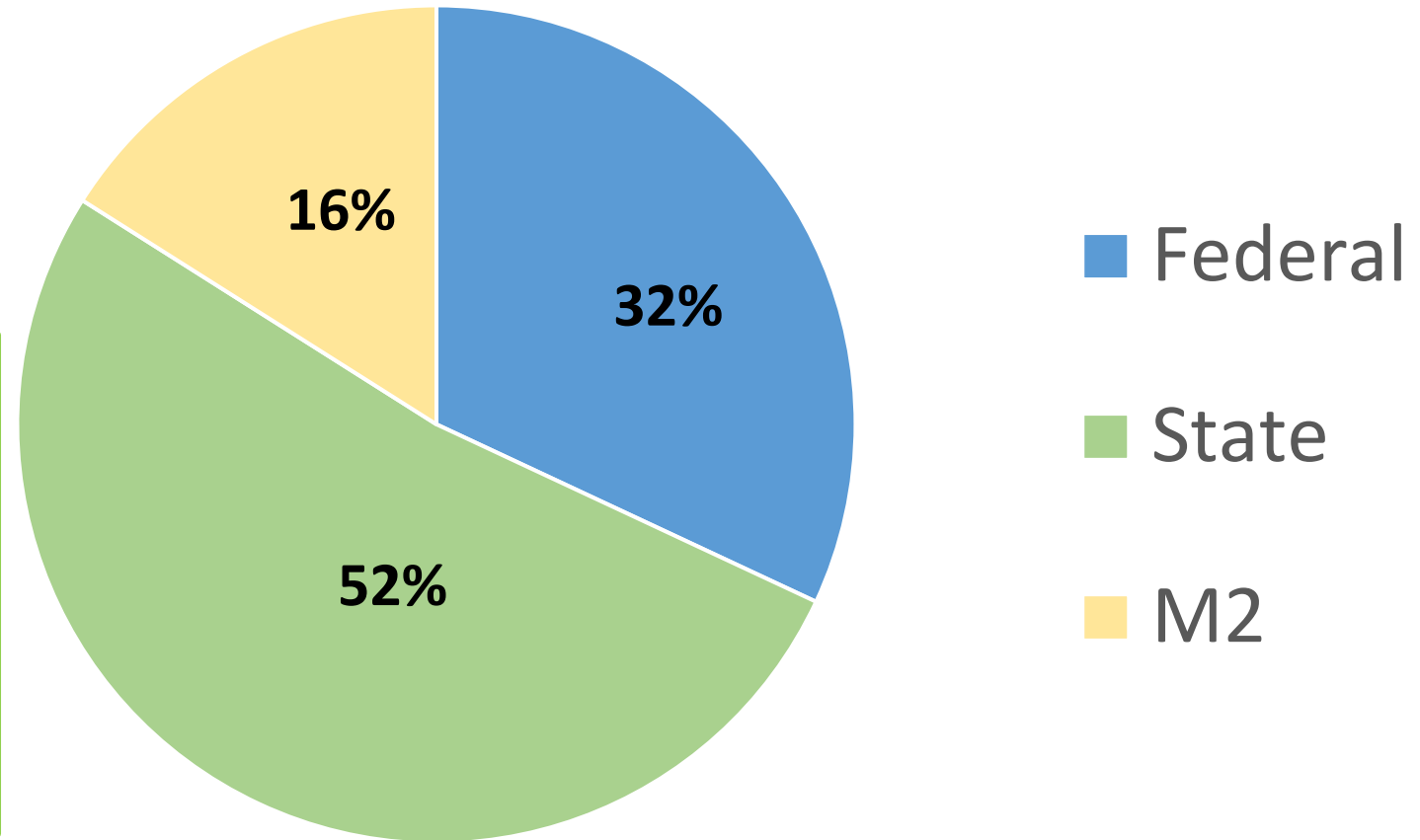


Project Improvements

- Add one high-occupancy vehicle lane in each direction
- Add one general purpose lane in each direction
- Add auxiliary lanes at certain locations



Funding Source for Current Budget



State Funding \$262.7 Million:

State Highway Operation and Protection Plan (SHOPP) \$42.7 Million

State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) \$80 Million

Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 Senate Bill 1 (SB1) \$140 Million

Current Budget of \$505 Million

Design

- Value engineering design reduced ROW impacts and costs
- Reduced 55 impacted properties to 33 properties
- Final Design to Caltrans Office Engineer on June 1st

ROW



- 33 properties impacted (24 commercial, three multi-residential, six public agencies)
- Appraisals were initiated in early 2019
- All offers and agreements to property owners have been presented
- 16 offers accepted to date
- Resolutions of necessity (RON) initiated in September 2020
- Fourteen RONs approved to date with four RONs remaining

Utility

- 13 utility companies impacted
- Utility relocation coordination was initiated in early 2018
- All 28 utility agreements executed

STAY INFORMED

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA), in cooperation with the Department of Transportation (Caltrans), is improving 4 miles of SR-55 between I-405 and I-5. The project will add a general purpose lane and a carpool lane in each direction to reduce congestion and improve traffic. Construction is expected to begin in mid-2021.
