Comprehensive Multimodal Corridor Plan Overview



- Study approx. 23-mile-long stretch of State Route 91 (SR-91).
- Improve mobility options and provide mode choices while preserving the character of the local community.
- Potential improvement options will be assessed that **benefit** the SR-91 corridor.
- Stakeholder engagement a key component of Plan.
- Provide a vision for the future of the corridor.
- Positions OCTA to compete for Senate Bill 1 congested corridor funds.

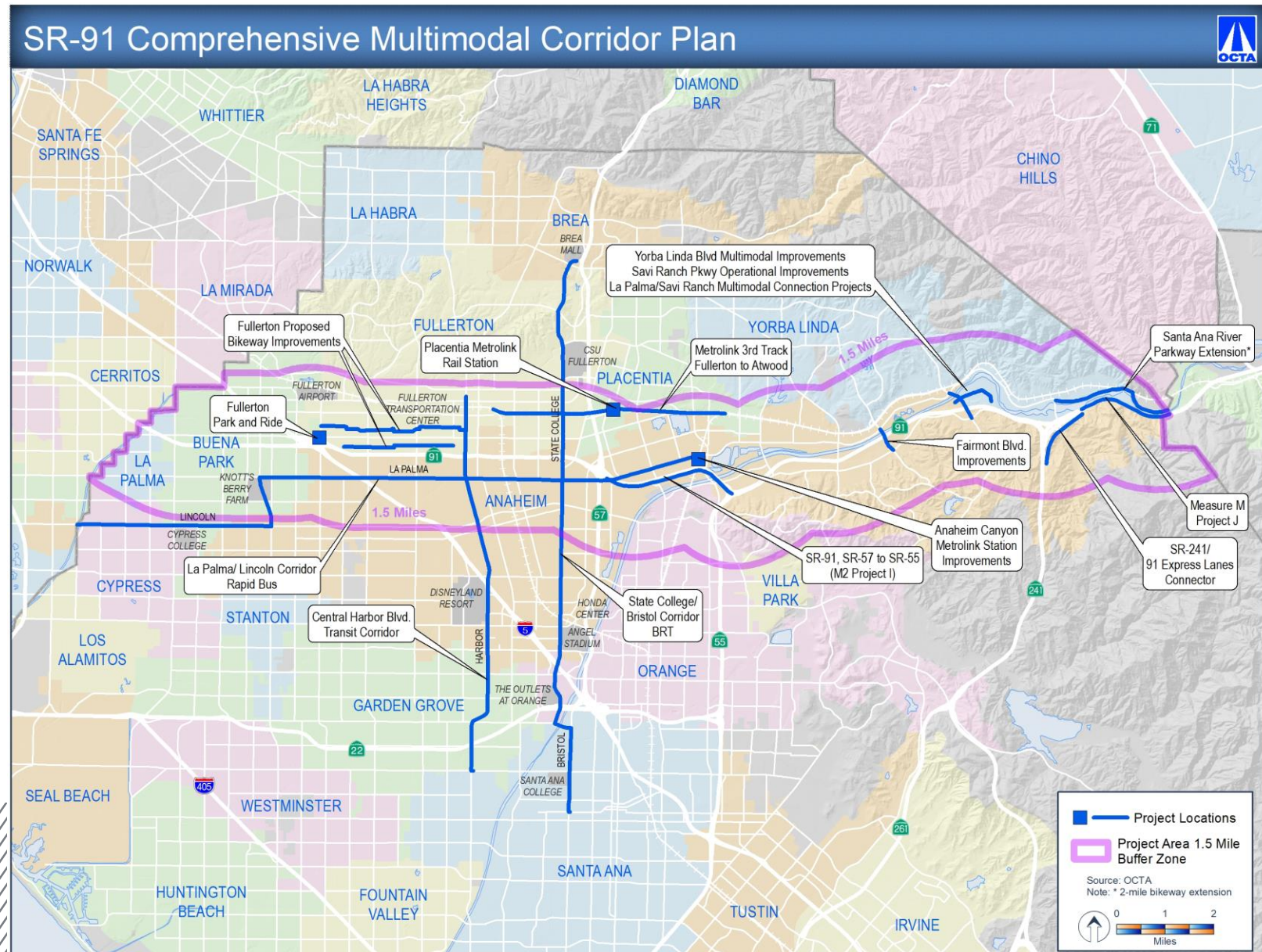


Corridor Background



- SR-91 is a major east-west state freeway linking Orange, Los Angeles, and the Riverside counties.
- The corridor traverses through a number of major cities.
- 91 Express Lanes span 18 miles through Orange and Riverside counties
- Corridor is predominantly built-out with a mix of residential, business, and other developments.
- Key east-west commuter corridor and connects affordable housing to employment, entertainment/recreation attractions, and academic institutions.
