## **OCTA Receives Public Feedback on Draft Bus Restructuring Plan**

The Orange County Transportation Authority's board of directors held a public hearing to allow community members to share their thoughts on a draft plan aimed at reshaping OC Bus service to better connect Orange County residents, workers and visitors to the places they want to travel.

The draft Making Better Connections plan, proposes to increase bus service on high ridership routes, reduces wait times and simplifies the structure of bus routes.

The draft plan came as a result of the initial phase of public input and extensive analysis. Additional input on the plan was received over the past several weeks at public meetings, community events, on board bus routes and through an online questionnaire.

After the public input is addressed, a final service plan will be brought to the board for consideration in the fall. If approved by the OCTA board, the improvements will be implemented as early as next year.
