Board Receives Update on Study Aimed at Improving O.C.'s Transit Future

The OCTA board received an update on the 2024 OC Transit Vision Master Plan, a study that aims to improve public transit options throughout Orange County during the next 30 years.

OCTA has identified 12 transit corridors with opportunities for future transportation investment. These corridors were selected based on overall travel demand, existing bus ridership, equity, and proximity to key destinations, among other factors.

Input from the public is a crucial part of developing the proposed strategies and options that will help shape the OC Transit Vision.
