SIGN FEATURES

- 10-foot columns elevate the sign to be visible, but not distracting, to drivers
- Internal up-lighting illuminates the sign during evening hours
- Stone veneer plaster used for the supporting columns provides a visually appealing character, while being a durable material requiring minimal maintenance
