82 DEATHS

in California from train-related accidents, between January and November 2009



80 PERCENT

Of Orange County residents are not aware of enforcement rules and regulations on the railroad tracks



64 PERCENT

Of collisions with trains occur during daylight hours



30 MPH

Is the average speed of a train during most train collisions



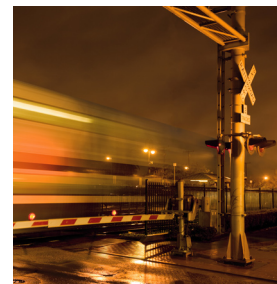
75 PERCENT

Of train collisions occur within 25 miles of a driver's home



90 MPH

Is the maximum speed of a train



5,800 VEHICLES

Is the average number that collides with trains each year in the U.S.



40 TIMES

More likely a motorist will die in a collision with a train than in a collision with another vehicle



1 MILE

Is the distance it takes for a train to stop while traveling at 55 miles per hour



4,000 CARS

Are needed to equal the weight of one train – an average of 180 tons
