In 1995, the 91 Express Lanes debuted as a privately funded tollway that offered a convenient opportunity to travel between Orange and Riverside counties at consistently reliable speeds. Now publicly owned and managed by OCTA, the express lanes continue to offer a safe, time-saving travel alternative.





Update on 91 Project

In late 2015, construction on the 8-mile extension of the 91 Express Lanes into Riverside hit the 50 percent mark. Led by the Riverside County Transportation Commission (RCTC), this milestone is part of the 91 Project that is also adding regular lanes, auxiliary lanes and direct express lane connectors from the northbound 15 to the westbound 91 and from the eastbound 91 to the southbound 15.

The extension is expected to be completed in 2017. Please slow down and drive safely near construction areas. Be alert, watch for signs and follow the 55 MPH speed limit within the project limits. Do CNG Cars Qualify for A Special Access Account?

The 91 Express Lanes offers a discounted special access account for pure zero-emission vehicles, such as fully electric cars and vehicles powered by hydrogen fuel cells. Compressed natural gas (CNG) cars are classified by the state as an "advanced technology partially zero-emissions vehicle" and do not qualify. On freeways outside of toll lanes, drivers of CNG vehicles who obtain a white clean air vehicle sticker from the DMV are allowed to travel as a single occupant in carpool lanes. On the 91 Express Lanes, CNG vehicles can use the HOV 3+

carpool lane only when three or more people are in the vehicle. Please remember that a transponder is required for travel on the 91 Express Lanes.

Safe Driving Tips for Those Dark, Rainy Days

Between the low light levels of daylight saving time and the abundant rain of the predicted El Nino, driving conditions may be challenging this winter.

Fortunately, there are a number of steps you can take to keep safe:

- Check and clean your headlights, taillights, brake lights, signal lights, and windshield wipers to make sure they all function properly. Manufacturers recommend changing wiper blades annually.
- Turn on your lights so you can see and others can see you. Use them an hour before sunset and an hour after sunrise. Using your windshield wipers? California law requires you to turn your full lights on at the same time.
- Slow down and leave extra distance between your car and the one ahead of you.
- Stay alert for skidding or sliding vehicles.
- Avoid crossing traffic lanes.

If something goes wrong on the 91 Express Lanes, pull over in one of the enforcement areas (the widened areas in the median). If you can't reach an enforcement area, pull over to the far left shoulder. In both cases, turn on your flashing hazard lights. Equipped with specially marked tow trucks and service vehicles, the Customer Assistance Service Patrol will be dispatched to help you whether you're out of gas, have a flat tire, or need your vehicle towed to safety. And the services are free.
