Buena Park Station

Orange County’s northernmost commuter rail station is here. Located at Lakeknoll Drive and Dale Avenue in the City of Buena Park, the station is the 11th Metrolink rail stop in Orange County.

Conveniently situated between a Cal State Fullerton housing complex and a new town house development, the Buena Park Station is part of a growing trend toward transit-oriented development.

A comfortable and reliable travel alternative gets on track for Buena Park.

The station offers nearby residents an alternative way to get to work, school or to fun destinations. Convenient Metrolink trains can take passengers to Los Angeles, central and southern Orange County, Riverside and Oceanside.

Nearly ____ Metrolink passengers use the station daily, which helps alleviate congestion at the busy Fullerton train station.

The City of Buena Park oversees the maintenance of the station.

Buena Park Highlights

- Provides Metrolink service (91 Line and Orange County Line)
- Public restrooms
- Comfortable waiting area equipped with benches and shaded structures
- Plaza area with gazebo
- Distinctive clock tower nearly 70 feet tall
- Pedestrian bridge with elevator and stairs
- Information kiosk and automated ticket vending machine
- Bicycle racks and lockers
- 300 surface parking spaces
- Connecting OCTA bus service on Route 25 and 29

Metrolink is Southern California’s rail system linking residential communities to employment and activity centers. Metrolink is operated by the Southern California Regional Rail Authority (SCRRA) – a joint powers authority of five member agencies representing the counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside, San Bernardino and Ventura. As one of five member agencies, OCTA administers all of Orange County’s Metrolink rail corridor service.
