

Construction Alert Pile Driving at Newland Street

- WHAT: As part of the Garden Grove Freeway (SR-22) Improvement Project, pile driving will occur at Newland Street on the westbound side of the freeway. Pile driving is necessary to place the columns for the expanded portion of the bridge. <u>Pile driving causes vibration and noise, and nearby residents will feel and hear this activity.</u>
- WHEN: The pile driving activity will begin as early as Thursday, September 29, during day-time hours and will last for about a month.
- WHERE: The part of the SR-22 freeway at Newland Street will be will be under construction.

We will regularly notify you when construction activities may impact your community.

This activity will cause noise, dust and vibration. Engineers will be on site to ensure work is completed quickly and efficiently. Every effort will be made to minimize impacts to residents, businesses and motorists throughout this and all phases of construction.

Due to unforeseen operational factors or inclement weather, these dates and times may change.

BACKGROUND: The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) will oversee the SR-22 Improvement Project, which spans the cities of Westminster, Garden Grove, Santa Ana and Orange. The major improvements to the SR-22 will include: a carpool lane in each direction between Tustin Avenue and Valley View Street, auxiliary lanes between interchanges and soundwalls along the project limits.
