Speed Limit Reduction Through Orange Crush

WHAT: As part of the Garden Grove Freeway (SR-22) Improvement Project, the speed limit on southbound SR-57 connector to the westbound SR-22 will be temporarily reduced to 25 mph.

WHERE: The southbound SR-57 connector to the westbound SR-22. This connector will be reconfigured and moved on temporary pavement a little to the southeast of its current configuration

WHEN: Beginning as early as Wednesday, April 20 through early 2006.

WHY: In an effort to ensure safety of both motorists and construction crews, the speed limit will be reduced through the Orange Crush while the SR-22 Improvement Project reconfigures the connectors to ease the flow of traffic through the area.

OCTA Reminds motorists to please drive with extra caution and reduced speeds while traveling through freeway work zones.

Due to unforeseen operational factors or inclement weather, these dates and times may change.

BACKGROUND: The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) will oversee the SR-22 Improvement Project, which spans the cities of Westminster, Garden Grove, Santa Ana and Orange. The major improvements to the SR-22 will include: a carpool lane in each direction between Tustin Avenue and Valley View Street, auxiliary lanes between interchanges and soundwalls along the project limits.
